Description

Reporting to the Supply Chain manager, you will be in charge of all customers and carrier management ensuring on-time worldwide distribution of high-quality radiopharmaceuticals products. You will ensure the coordination of customer orders, the management of finished products' inventory, implementation and optimization of standard operating procedures, work instructions and quality records related to the department. As back-up of the Manufacturing Manager, you will be in charge of the secondary packaging and labelling of finished products in accordance with the appropriate documentation in place to ensure production timelines are met.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Business point of contact for all customers,
- Responsible for customer's qualification and master data follow-up,
- Participation in the establishment of commercial contracts with customers,
- Responsible for the analysis, redaction, sending and follow-up of customer price offers,
- Responsible for the selection, qualification, negotiation, establishment of commercial contracts and performance monitoring of carriers
- Responsible for the management of customer orders (reception, verification, registration, acknowledgement of receipt and order confirmation)
